Family History

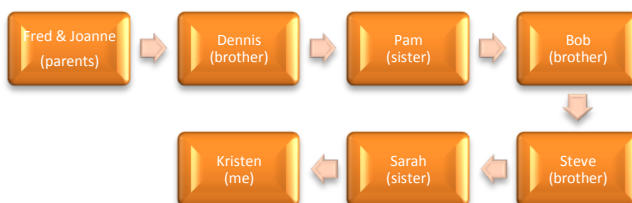
